Team Rules & Policies

I. Mission Statement

- a. The Ohio Squirrels Water Polo Club (OSWPC) is a co-ed masters water polo club and was established:
 - i. To create and sustain a long-term water polo club program in the Cincinnati region,
 - ii. To train and compete as Ohio Squirrels in collegiate club, masters and NCAA invitationals
 - iii. To recruit, develop, encourage athletes of all ages and ability throughout Ohio to participate in the sport of water polo

iv. To collaborate with other water polo programs in the Ohio and Midwest regions to continue to grow water polo

II. Non Profit Information

- a. The Ohio Squirrels Water Polo Club is recognized by the State of Ohio as a 501c7
- b. 501c7 is defined as a non-profit social club supported by membership fees
- c. The Ohio Squirrels accept donations to help with pool rental, equipment costs and other miscellaneous fees.

III. Player Participation

- a. All members of the Ohio Squirrels Water Polo Club are required to be a part of American Water Polo. American Water Polo provides individual player insurance as well as governing body support for the club. More information can be found at www.americanwaterpolo.org.
- b. All members must be up to date with member dues in order to participate. See dues information
- c. All members must be in good standing with the Ohio Squirrels Water Polo Club Player Agreement in section IV. Not abiding by this agreement could lead to suspension or removal from the club.
- d. All members must follow the Mission Statement of the Ohio Squirrel Water Polo Club

IV. Player Agreement

- a. As a player of the Ohio Squirrels Water Polo Club I agree to:
 - i. Treat all players with utmost respect both in and out of the water
 - ii. Treat officials at invitationals with utmost respect both in and out of the water
 - iii. Treat other teams with utmost respect both in and out of the water
 - iv. Support the mission statement of the Ohio Squirrels Water Polo Club
 - v. Help with setup and breakdown at practices as much as possible
- b. By not abiding by the above standards, I understand this could lead to suspension or removal from the club

V. Traveling Rules & Policies

- **a.** Players wishing to travel to tournaments must be in good standing with the club under both the Player Participation and Player Agreement Sections
- b. For distant tournaments (outside of Cincinnati), players must be 18 years or older
- **c.** Travel and tournament fees are covered by the individual players attending the invitational and not covered by the club dues
- **d.** Attendance is taken in consideration when traveling to a tournament

e. If any player traveling with the team should miss a game at any tournament (or a home tournament), unless excused by an OSWPC Executive Officer, may be subject to probationary measures.

VI. Dues Information

- a. OSWPC designed dues to enhance the playing experience.
- b. Dues will not provide any profits or personal net gains for members of OSWPC.
- c. Players are encouraged to contact a member of the OSWPC Executive Committee for any special circumstance regarding dues, which will be considered and addressed as needed.
- d. Dues cover facility/pool rental, team equipment, advertisement/recruiting efforts and social events. Dues do not cover all expenses for traveling members of OSWPC. (i.e. tournament entrance fees, travel expenses, lodging).
- e. Additional expenses will vary for each tournament. OSWPC is not accountable for these changes.

Dear Current and Prospective Club Members: I am pleased to present the 2019 Club Dues Structure.

First, all members must join **American Water Polo** to be able to participate with the Ohio Squirrels Water Polo Club. Membership details are available on the website: www.americanwaterpolo.org. The cost for ages 23 and older is \$60, while for ages younger than 22 is \$50. This cost is not included in the Club Dues Structure.

Below is our 2019 Dues Structure. For 2019, we have practice offerings 2 Wednesdays a month in both the 1st Session (Spring) and 3rd Session (Fall). We are still maintaining Wednesdays every week during the 2nd Session (Summer). To help keep your costs down for our membership, we have provided incentive programs and sponsorship opportunities that can benefit you as an individual member and the club. Annual Due Payments:

Like last year, an option for paying dues on an annual basis is available. Annual Due Payments is available for those who want to take advantage of paying full dues for the entire calendar year. Those who choose this receive 10% off (or \$40.00) their annual fee, admission into home tournaments in the spring & fall and admission into Lake Polo which is in August The total amount due for annual dues payment is \$375.00 Full amount must be submitted by January 31 to receive all incentives.

The Annual Due Payment Includes:

10% Discount on Annual Dues
Access to all practices, scrimmages for the entire year
Practice Value – Estimated 80 Practices a year - \$4.60 per practice
Admission to Nutty Invitational (February) - \$25.00 Value
Admission to Lake Polo (August)
Admission to Harvest Classic (October) - \$25.00 Value

Individual Session Dues:

Members may choose to pay for each session separately. Club Dues are divided into three (3) sessions, each of which cost \$130.00. The items listed above (Invites, Lake Polo) are additional fees. We are creating an even greater incentive for members to pay for the entire year (above) v. per session. The Individual Session Dues is divided as follows:

For major holidays such as Memorial Day Weekend, 4th of July, Labor Day & Christmas, we will not be having practice.

Practice Days, Times and Locations are Subject to Change. For outdoor practices, if weather becomes an issue, we will be communicating whether practice is on or not via email, Facebook and Twitter.

Annual v. Single Session Savings:

Annual Membership - \$375.00

3 Individual Sessions plus 2 tournaments/lake polo - \$480.00

2 Individual Sessions plus 2 tournaments/lake polo - \$340.00

By signing up for an Annual Membership, you are saving \$105.00 for the entire year (22%)

Half Session Dues:

If a member believes you can only attend practices up until mid-way or after the mid-way through the end session, you can take the half dues option of \$70.00. For college students, the rate will be \$55.00 for half of a session.

Sponsorship – Incentive Program:

To help reduce the expenses of our club, we have initiated a Sponsorship – Incentive Program. If you as a member bring on a sponsor for the club in 2019, you get 25% of the total sponsorship toward your own personal dues. For example, if you get a company to sponsor \$100.00, \$25.00 goes toward your membership fees. Please email Adam Gunn for a copy of the sponsorship letter. We are organized and operating as a 501c7 tax exempt organization. You are limited to \$375.00 toward your 2019 Dues.

Individual – Sponsorship Program:

Another way a member can help contribute to the team is by purchasing a new water polo ball, decorating it and returning it to the club. Anyone can decorate the ball and with any color. This can be an ongoing reminder of the support we get both from members and members' families. This can be done anytime throughout the year. A new water polo ball is \$35.00.

New Member Recruiting – Incentive Program:

We greatly value new members joining our club. Any new member recruited by a current member on the club will be rewarded with a referral bonus. If that new member signs up for a session or an entire year, the current member receives 20% of the fee they paid. If a member signs up for 1 session (\$140), the current member receives \$28 back on their membership dues. Recruited members must be brand new members of the club and have no history of paying OSWPC dues in the past.

Club Fundraising Events:

Throughout the year, we will be having club fundraising events in which we will partner with local restaurants. Please keep a look out for when and where these events are.

New Members:

New members are always welcome to join the Club. New members are permitted to try out the club for three (3) practices before dues payment is obligated.

Away Tournament Dues:

Tournaments fees are charged to cover the cost of admissions into a tournament. The cost the Club assumes ranges from \$250 to \$500 depending on the tournament. Each attendee will share the cost of the tournament which usually ranges from \$25 to \$35. These fees do not include fuel, lodging or food.
